

Priya Parrotta, PhD

Dr. Priya Parrotta is an environmental historian, composer and author whose work dismantles and transcends borders to unite humans with each other and the natural world. She is the Founder and Director of Music & the Earth International, a globally acclaimed academic and artistic initiative which seeks to bring multicultural environmental consciousness into the public sphere through the composition and interdisciplinary presentation of original world music. She has written, sung and produced seven albums which span the world's diverse musical genres and are dedicated to deep and lasting peace on Earth. Priya's scholarly work focuses on environmental and sociocultural coexistence on tropical islands in the Caribbean and Pacific. She authored an academic book titled *The Politics of Coexistence in the Atlantic World* at the age of twenty-five, and has since completed two additional manuscripts titled *To Dream Again: Island Environmentalism through Music* and *The Paradise Industry: The Making of Waikīkī Beach, 1890-1930*. She also has published widely on the intersections between environmentalism and the arts. Her work has been featured, by invitation, in environmental conferences and venues worldwide and has earned her national and international recognition. Priya is a Senior Fellow in Environmental History and Music at the Safina Center and a nominee for the United States Artists Fellowship in Music.
